George was born in 1738 in Schoharie, in what was then Albany County. He married Anna Hummel, who had been been in Ulster Co., NY in 1748, on 3 November 1763. George and Anna had eleven distinct the house of the County of the Co

ctatores netween the years 1788 and 1780, three of whem died years, George Richtmyer resided east of the Middle Fort in Schedurie. He joined in the attack on McDenaM's forces at Chryster's Millis and served in defense of the Middle Fort during Johnsur's Rail. Serving the partiest cause on what was then the frontier, George was commissioned a Capitain in the Albane Commo Willist on 20 or 1785. In which

post he was re-appointed on 20 Feb 1778.

George died in Schoharie in 1803 and it buried in the Richtmyer Family Farm Cemetery in Middleburgh, Schoharie County. [Editor's note: Compatrics's Scribner's application
