#### ANCESTOR CORNER By Compatrist Dennis F.M. Marr For several years I had researched my Zeilman family of Albany, NY, finally getting them back to a Johann Ludwir Zeilmann who appears in the

Johann Ledwig Zeilmann who appears in the records of the First Latheren Chart of Allony in 1786. I was able to determine that dobases had 1786. I was able to determine that dobases had necessary to the state of the state of the state of the section Allone Sollow, a German immigrant who settled in Stine Arabia and served in the French & Indian War and the Revolution with the Tryon County Millin. Johann and Dorethen's on John Antheny Zellinn ararried Eliza Lubrie of Albany, and the wife Elizabeth Bolder, also a daughter of Andreas Relier.

While performing searches on a Family Tree Maker CD (1812) - Milliary Records Selected NY Revolutionary War Records 1775-1849) I put a hit on Johan Ludokip Zillimans. Persions research had failed to lecate him in any celonial Rev. War records. On this CD, I found him in the index to the IBETRINA, the messive eemplation of 10,400 Hessin Troops who served from Germany on the Hessin Troops who served from Germany on the Online Control of the Control of th

A query to the Rosecook Hessian site elicited the information that Johann had neved with the Hessi-Baran Chaoscur Carps, an elite unit of hunters and abraphatories from Bavaria. He was discharged at Quebec City in 1783 and disappeared from Canadian records. In 1785, as John Zelfman, he leased have in Albanys on the lease his occupation

was "Hattlet."

A researcher in Munich pulled his 3 military files for sue from the archives at the University of Marburg, confirming his enlistment in 1779. He had perviously served 4 years in the Imperial array. On his calistatent record his occupation is given as "Hattmether," that is, hat maker. I also received his thristening record (horn 28 May 1751) from the Examelical Landerson Charch of Extanses.
